SCHOOL AGE PROGRAMS (Latchkey)

WHAT? A School-Age Program (SAP) is a before and after-school program which gives students time to have fun and enjoy friends while under the supervision of caring adults. The program is tailored to meet the developmental characteristics and needs of the individual child. Certificated teachers direct district programs. Kid Care Connection, Park Board and YMCA programs are directed by Kansas Department of Health and Environment certified staff.

WHEN? The program hours are posted at each site. Services are generally provided two hours before and two hours after school.

COST: A fifteen or thirteen dollar (\$15.00/\$13.00) enrollment fee is paid upon application. The tuition is based on the number of hours of service contracted by the parent daily and fees are collected in advance. The following daily rates are based on an approved Food Form application at your child's school:

The third child in each family attending a school-age program will pay ½ of all contracted hours. Any additional children after the third child will also pay ½ of all contracted hours.

There may be an additional fee for breakfast at some sites based on the school-lunch formula. Field trips and summer activities may require activity fees. Parents may apply for SRS subsidy.

ENROLLMENT: Children must be 5 to 12 years of age. Enrollment is first come, first serve, space available, and staffing is based on a 1 to 15 ratio. The parent must complete an **Enrollment Form, a Parent Agreement, an Appointment of Agent, Health Forms, and pay a \$15.00/\$13.00 enrollment fee before the child is admitted.**

Enrollment procedures follow the guidelines for Licensed Child Care facilities as determined by the State Department of Health and Environment.
