Anyone who has a Title VII Student Eligibility Certification form (506) on file with the Wichita Public Schools Native American Program.

The form will ask for the student name, the name of the tribe, band or group, and the parent or guardian dated signature.

This form will not have to be completed every year but will follow students through their education in the district.

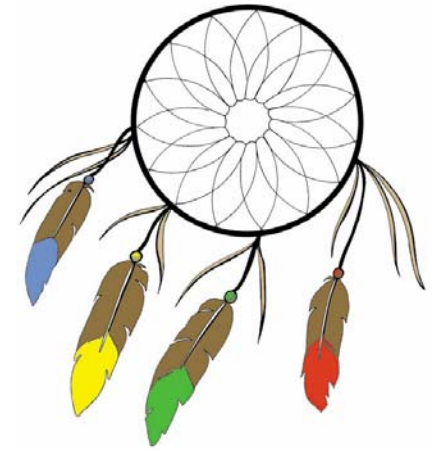

The Native American Indian population of the Wichita Public School district is approximately 3% of the entire enrollment. This is the largest enrollment of Native American students in the State of Kansas in a single school system.



The Native American Indian student is as diverse as the population of the city where these students reside. While attending virtually all the Wichita Public School sites in the city, they represent approximately 78 bands and tribes from across the United States.
